

Supervisor Landi called the workshop to order at 7 PM. Present were: Supervisor Landi, Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Nelson, Councilman Queipo and Councilman Wells. Highway Superintendent Moore and Town Attorney Naughton were also present.

Committee Reports

Councilman Queipo made the motion, seconded by Councilman Wells to purchase a sound system from Access Communication Systems for up to \$17,000. All Approved.

Councilman Wells made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to do a 2022 budget amendment to raise the salary of the Heavy Motor Equipment Operator to \$25.50 per hour. All Approved. Councilman Wells made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to update the Employee Guidebook to set the probation period for new hires to 90 days from the current 180 days. All approved.

Councilman Nelson introduced Local Law #1 of 2022 – Short Term Rentals. The Board will study and come back with additions, deletions and corrections before it is finalized for a public hearing. Councilman Nelson made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to appoint Dixon Onderdonk to the Ulster County Planning Board. All Approved.

Councilman Hoffman thanked the Highway Department for their help during a Fire Company call at the Bluestone Acres Park.

Attorney Kelly Naughton has talked to Dixon Onderdonk about the Planning Board. She is working on a resolution to have the Town take over Gray Lane.

Heather Heddleson, President of the Sawkill Auxiliary approached the Board about the Auxiliary holding a flag fund raiser on the field – around Memorial Day. She will come back with more information.

Supervisor Landi made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to pay the town bills that were presented at the meeting. All approved.
