

Supervisor Landi called the workshop to order at 7 PM. Present were Supervisor Landi, Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Nelson, Councilman Queipo, and Councilman Wells. Highway Superintendent Moore, and Town Attorney Ashley Torre were also present.

### **Committee Reports**

**Councilman Wells** reported that the summer rec is on – he has two counselors that will work as co-directors. The budget will not have to be modified.

**Councilman Hoffman** reported that Highway Superintendent Ed Moore met with the Town Engineer about Hill Rd. The engineer stated that the work that the Highway Department has done will be an improvement, but he will have a report about the rest of Hill Rd. There are problems with the ledge, the swale not big enough and some trees need to be taken down by Sawkill Rd. Councilman Hoffman made the motion, seconded by Councilman Wells for the town engineer to also look at the Wintergreen Hill bridge. All Approved.

**Councilman Queipo** reported that he has heard nothing from the Sheriff's Department. They are still waiting on microphones for the speaker system.

**Councilman Nelson** reported that the retirement dinner for Alfie was good. Alfie retired after 39 years in the Highway Department. The Planning Board meeting will be this coming Monday (6/20) – it will be online only.

**Supervisor Landi** had received a noise complaint about kids riding their ATV on their own property at 4:30 PM on a Friday afternoon. There was no reason to revisit the possibility of a noise law currently.

### **New Business**

**Councilman Nelson** made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to appoint Dixon Onderdonk to the County Planning Board. All Approved.

**Supervisor Landi** made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to appoint John-Paul Sliva as an alternate to the Planning Board. All Approved.

There was a discussion on having a town party sometime in the Fall. Councilman Wells made the motion, seconded by Councilman Nelson to table this subject to the Town Board meeting in July.

**Questions & Comments**

Highway Superintendent Ed Moore informed the Town Board that he had heard from the owners from Woodstock Harley Davidson about his parking lot and Beesmer Road. That road (Beesmer Road) is not listed as a town road.

Highway Superintendent Ed Moore informed the Town Board that the Highway Department will be working 4 10 hour days (Monday – Thursday) during the summer.

Councilman Nelson made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to replace some of our welcome signs that have started to fade away. All Approved.

A discussion was held to build an outside community library in remembrance of all Town of Kingston residents that have passed away. Councilman Nelson will check into the pricing of this project.

Councilman Queipo made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to pay the bills presented at the meeting. All Approved.

Councilman Hoffman made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to move for adjournment. All Approved. The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 PM.
