

Supervisor Landi called the workshop to order at 7 PM. Present were Supervisor Landi, Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Nelson, and Councilman Queipo, Councilman Wells was absent. Highway Superintendent Ed Moore, and Town Attorney Ashley Torre were also present.

Committee Reports

Councilman Hoffman made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to purchase an AED storage (cost up to \$600). All Approved. It will be hanging in the meeting room. The Highway Department will install it.

Councilman Nelson reported that the Town Party is scheduled for October 16th – 1 to 4 PM. He will forward the information to Dennis so that the information will be in the newsletter.

Councilman Queipo reported he had received an email from the County Department of Public Works requesting up-to-date insurance forms. Their current file shows our insurance coverage through 2018. (NOTE: The Town has already sent a copy of the updated insurance forms to the County). The speaker system had a slight hum in it. The vendor has come out and fixed the hum. The Sheriff and the State Police have increased their patrols in our Town. Vinnie and Dennis will contact our IT Company (Hudson River Technologies) for their recommendations on purchasing a laptop to use in conjunction with the new speaker system so that the Town can WEBEX or Zoom meetings. The front door does not always close, plus the handicapped buttons are not working. Councilman Nelson said he will contact the vendor.

Highway Superintendent Ed Moore gave his report about Hill Road and Wintergreen Road Bridge. New larger culverts have been installed along Hill Road. The ditch by the Sleight's house has been filled in and cones have been placed to alert drivers where the edge of the road is located. The Highway Department checks Hill Road every time it rains to check if those culverts are doing the job. Ed had been in contact with the Town's Engineer on plans for the Wintergreen Hill Bridge. The South Road sign has been replaced.

Highway Superintendent Ed Moore would like to put Truck #3 up for auction and replace it with a new pick-up Truck to be purchased at the State Bid price (\$53,400). A roll call vote was taken. Councilman Hoffman – yes; Councilman Nelson – yes; Councilman Queipo – no; Supervisor Landi – yes. The motion was adopted yes – 3, no -1, absent – 1.

Councilman Hoffman will head the committee for our Tree Lighting ceremony in December.

Town Clerk Weiss has been given permission to have political parties (as recognized by the Ulster County Board of Elections) to hold monthly meetings in the Town meeting room starting in January 2023.

Supervisor Landi made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to pay the bills presented at today's meeting. All Approved.

Councilman Nelson made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to move for adjournment. All Approved. The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.
