

The regular Town Board meeting that was called to order by Deputy Supervisor Queipo at 7 PM with the pledge to the flag and a moment of silence.

Present were Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Nelson, and Deputy Supervisor Queipo and Councilman Wells. Supervisor Landi was absent. Also present were Town Attorney Kelly Naughton, Zoning Board of Appeals chairman Blake Jackson, Code Enforcement Officer Bob Cologero, Planning Board Chairman Dixon Onderdonk and Daily Freeman reporter Bill Kemble. There were five Town residents also in attendance.

Deputy Supervisor Queipo announced that any questions regarding 850 Route 28 will be referred to our Town Attorney.

A motion by Councilman Nelson and seconded by Councilman Wells to approve all the January minutes that were reviewed by the Town Board prior to the meeting be accepted. All approved.

Deputy Supervisor Queipo read the Supervisors Report and Town Clerk Weiss read the Town Clerk's report.

The general bills, highway bills and interfund transfers were reviewed by the Town Board.

Interfund Transfers

Councilman Hoffman made the motion, seconded by Councilman Wells to make the following interfund transfers: Transfer from American Rescue Act into A1620.4 Town Hall Contractual \$1,800 to cover expenses (Website); transfer from A1990.4 Contingency into A 8020.4 Planning Board Contractual \$1,056.66 to cover expenses; transfer from A1990.4 Contingency into A3510.4 Animal Control Contractual \$100.00 to cover expenses; and transfer from A230.7 Supervisor's Investment into A8020.41 Stormwater \$9,546.01 to cover expenses. All Approved.

General and Highway Bills

A motion was made by Councilman Hoffman and seconded by Councilman Nelson to pay the following general bills Claim #28 thru #72 totaling \$33,715.22 and highway bills Claim #73 thru #83, totaling \$38,543.14. All approved. (See Minute Book for a breakdown of the actual bills).

Committee Reports

Councilman Nelson went to the Planning Board meeting. There was a public meeting concerning Gray Lane.

Councilman Hoffman had no report.

Councilman Wells reported that Code Enforcement Officer Cologero collected \$115 in January (\$65 in Building Permits, \$50 in abstracts).

Councilman Queipo reported that the Stormwater MS-4 report has been completed. DEC will be visiting to perform an audit report on the MS-4 report next week. Code Enforcement Officer Cologero, Superintendent of Highway Ed Moore, Deputy Highway Superintendent Tom Cole III and an official from our engineering firm (Crawford and Associates) will accompany the DEC official.
