

Supervisor Landi called the workshop to order at 7 PM. Present were Supervisor Landi, Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Nelson, Councilman Queipo, and Councilman Wells. Highway Superintendent Moore, Code Enforcement Officer Bob Cologero, Town Attorney Ashley Torre and 3 members of the public were also present.

Committee Reports

Councilman Hoffman and Code Enforcement Officer Cologero reported that they did an inspection of the property at the Town line. The owner of the property was with them during the inspection. Councilman Hoffman noted that a lot of the property was getting cleaned up but there was still a lot more cleaning to be done. The owner agreed with Councilman Hoffman and Code Enforcement Officer Cologero assessment. Councilman Hoffman made the motion, seconded by Councilman Nelson to extend the time frame on cleaning the property by 3 months starting April 19th. The owner understood the action that the Town Board was taking. The motion was approved by a 5-0 vote. Councilman Hoffman and Code enforcement Officer Cologero will continue to make inspections on the property and report back to the Board. The members of the public that came to support the tenant left the meeting.

Councilman Nelson went to the Planning Board meeting in April. They didn't have a quorum, so they held discussions about the comprehensive plan. Secretary Roz Borghere gave a quick background on the history of the Town.

Councilman Nelson suggested that the Board should ask the public again for people interested in becoming a member of the planning board.

Councilman Wells reported that Food truck night will be held on Friday, June 2 from 6 – 9 PM. Set-up will start at 4 PM. Councilman Wells made the motion, seconded by Councilman Nelson to establish a \$50 special event fee. All Approved.

Councilman Queipo reminded everyone about the Historian presentation scheduled for April 22nd. Councilman Queipo made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to have Supervisor Landi sign the MOU with Archtop Fiber LLC. The vote was 4 yes (Landi, Hoffman, Queipo and Wells; and 1 no vote

(Nelson). Motion approved 4-1. Councilman Queipo reported that the Sheriff deputy will be up to 3 days a week – a 12-12 shift.

Councilman Queipo made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman that the Town lease 5 radios (4 for the Town Board – 1 for Town Supervisor). The cost will be \$155 for 5 years. All Approved.

Old Business – None

New Business – Councilman Wells made the motion seconded by Councilman Nelson to move the July Town Board meeting from July 3rd to July 5th. All Approved.

Highway Superintendent Ed Moore released Form 284 to the Board. Councilman Hoffman made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to accept Form 284. All Approved.

Highway Superintendent Ed Moore is reviewing the applications that have been received regarding the opening in the Town Highway garage.

Supervisor Landi made the motion, seconded by Councilman Nelson to pay the bills presented at the meeting. All Approved.

Councilman Queipo made the motion, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to move for adjournment. All Approved. The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 PM.
