

Supervisor Landi called the workshop meeting to order at 7:01PM.

Present were Supervisor Landi, Councilman Nelson, Councilman Queipo, Councilman Wells, Highway Superintendent Sylvester, and Town Clerk Linda Nelson. Councilman Hoffman was at the very beginning of the meeting and then came back in about 30 minutes into the meeting.

A motion was made to approve the March workshop minutes as read, by Supervisor Landi and seconded by Councilman Wells. All approved.

Supervisor Landi made a motion to pay the bills and was seconded by Councilman Nelson. All approved.

Councilman Nelson discussed the Text my Gov program, how it works and the costs of the program, it is a one-time set up fee of \$750.00 and an annual cost of \$1,500.00. We will be looking at doing a town survey to see if it's worthwhile for the town.

Highway Superintendent Sylvester asked about spending money on topsoil and mulch for the playground to fill in the holes, it was agreed upon to use money from the ARPA funds. He also commented on the county working on Hill Rd., drilling holes and prepping for the pipe. He also started on roadside clean up on Jockey Hill Rd. He also mentioned the new tree was purchased and planted for \$400.00.

Councilman Wells had nothing to comment on.

Councilman Queipo went to the planning board meeting two days prior and mentioned the binders that John-Paul Sliva made up for the board members, as well as the fact that Casey Schwarz was appointed to the board to fill the vacant spot. He also brought up the comprehensive plan that they want the Town Board to review and make recommendations on. It was agreed upon that the Town Board would be doing that. He also commented that he had a couple companies that would come out to look estimates to continuing the wiring from the generator to the highway department.

Councilman Hoffman mentioned the Town hall carpets getting cleaned with a tentative date of April 26th, he mentioned the green house with the junk cars getting looked into by Bob and also the house across the street from the Town Hall, the swimming pool that was filled in is sinking and a danger and should be looked into by Bob as well. It was also verified that it was voted on that we keep the MS4 stormwater report. It was discussed because if we get out of it, we would have to pay to have it redone.

Ed Moore's application for the planning board alternate was brought forth for approval, it was voted on, Councilman Hoffman -Yes, Councilman Nelson – Yes, Councilman Queipo – Yes, Councilman Wells – Yes and Supervisor Landi – Yes. It was approved 5-0.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Councilman Queipo and seconded by Councilman Nelson. All approved. The workshop meeting was adjourned at 7:41PM.
