

Supervisor Landi called the workshop meeting to order at 7:07PM.

Present were Supervisor Landi, Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Wells, Highway Superintendent Sylvester, Town Clerk Linda Nelson and 3 members of the public. Councilman Nelson and Councilman Queipo was excused.

A motion was made to approve the June workshop minutes as read, by Supervisor Landi and seconded by Councilman Hoffman with the correction listing June minutes instead of January as it stated in the agenda. All approved.

Supervisor Landi made a motion to pay the general and highway bills, it was seconded by Councilman Hoffman. All approved.

Councilman Hoffman mentioned he is waiting for a couple of quotes from contractors to paint the Town Hall. He has a meeting set up for tomorrow to have someone look at the roof and get an estimate. He also mentioned he is still waiting for Empress Ambulance to get back to him with a contract.

Councilman Wells thanked the Rec Dept for all the work they did on the float for the Children's Day Parade, there were multiple compliments made and passed on about it, everyone loved it. He thanked the Ulster County Executive and Ulster County DPW for the loan of the radar speed sign. He has put in a request for pricing for permanent ones for the town to purchase.

Highway Superintendent Sylvester is requesting permission to spend \$34,000 to tar and chips East Ridge Dr., it would be paid for with CHIPS money. Councilman Wells motioned to approve to spend up to \$37,000 to take care of East Ridge Dr. and it seconded by Councilman Hoffman. All approved.

A roll call vote was made for Local Law #2-2024. Councilman Hoffman -YES, Councilman Wells -YES and Supervisor Landi -YES. Councilman Nelson and Queipo were absent for voting. Passed 3-0

A motion to adjourn was made by Supervisor Landi and seconded by Councilman Hoffman. All approved. The meeting was adjourned at 7:15PM.
