

Supervisor Landi called the workshop meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Present were Councilman Hoffman, Councilman Nelson, Councilman Wells and Supervisor Landi. Also present were Highway Superintendent Sylvester, Planning Board Deputy Chair Sliva, Planning Board member Long, Town Clerk Linda Nelson and 3 members of the public. Councilman Queipo was excused.

A motion was made to approve the August workshop minutes as read, by Supervisor Landi and seconded by Councilman Wells. All approved.

Supervisor Landi made a motion to pay the general and highway bills, it was seconded by Councilman Nelson. All approved.

Councilman Nelson Mentioned the planning board met Monday night, 530 Rt 28 is looking for approval for more working days overall, Deputy Chair Sliva mentioned they will be making a pretty significant increase.

Councilman Hoffman would like to get approval for purchasing an AED unit with cover for the town camp for \$2,474.55, funds will come out of the American Rescue Plan Act. Motion was made to approve by Councilman Wells and seconded by Councilman Nelson. All approved. Councilman Hoffman asked for approval to have Leanne Buchinger leave work to go to a serious ambulance calls for assistance with the EMTs, all approved discussing this with the Judge. He then brought forth asking for a vote to commit to Town of Ulster for ambulance service so it can be put out to bid. Motion was made by Supervisor Landi and seconded by Councilman Wells. All approved.

Town Clerk Linda Nelson brought up the need for a motion to authorize the letting of bids for the new refuse contract so it can be put out to bid. Councilman Nelson made the motion, and it was seconded by Councilman Hoffman. All approved.

Highway Superintendent Sylvester mentioned possibly hiring Tom Cole full time at the beginning of the year, there is more then enough work for 3 people.

Supervisor Landi mentioned the Planning Board vacancy, interviews will be set up shortly with the applicant.

Town of Kingston Resolution #2024-32 was voted on for Halloween Curfew, a motion was made by Councilman Nelson and seconded by Councilman Wells. All voted yes, for a vote of 4-0. All approved.

The bid process for the refuse contract was explained by Town Clerk Nelson and the fact that the 2025 budget will be in process over the upcoming weeks.

A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Wells and seconded by Councilman Hoffman. All approved. The meeting was adjourned at 7:16PM.
