Councilman Nelson mentioned that our previous IT company had locked us out of our emails, we have a new IT company that has all the information and hopefully by Friday, Monday at the latest they should have our emails back up and running properly.

Councilman Hurley mentioned Zena Development has delayed their meeting at Town of Ulster another month. He also mentioned they had their first comprehensive plan meeting last night, 7 people showed up and he is planning on meeting every 2 weeks. The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 29 at 7pm.

Councilman Moore commented that the highway department is doing well with all the ditch work they are doing all over the town.

Planning Board Chair Sliva mentioned the grant permission they need from the board. Councilman Wells made a motion that was seconded by Supervisor Hoffman, to move forward with the process. All approved.

Councilman Nelson mentioned that the board is going to keep a close eye on spring clean-up this year to see if it could possibly be moved to an every other year event. No decision will be made until after spring clean-up this year. It will be readdressed later.
